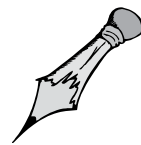
Fall Book Club – Apple Tree Pattern

Oh Nonfiction: Diagramming the 300s

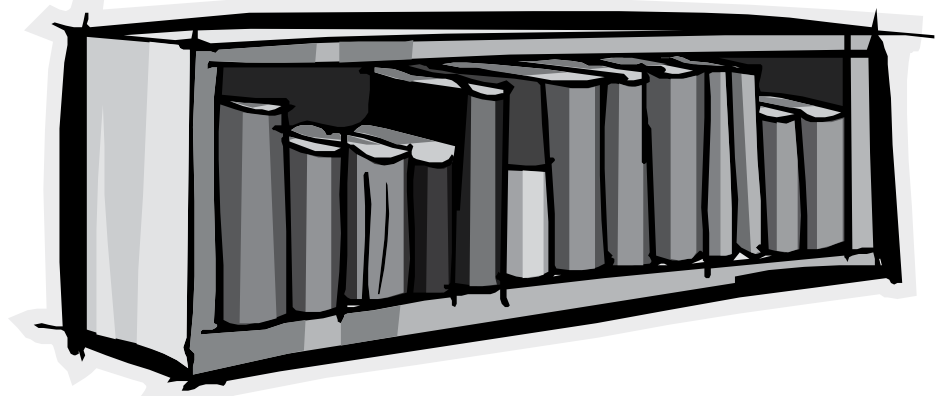
The 300 section of the Dewey Decimal system includes several traditional story forms. They include:

- Folktales: narrative stories told by word of mouth and passed down within a culture
- Fairy tales: stories featuring fantastic characters such as fairies, elves, goblins, trolls, witches, and giants, and including events of magic or enchantment
- Tall tales: stories that are greatly exaggerated and highly improbable; many are humorous and specific to a geographic region
- Legends: stories that are often retold and that might be true
- Fables: stories that illustrate a moral lesson which may be stated at the end; many include animals or elements of nature

Take the time to introduce your students to the similarities and differences among these five story forms. If time allows, use several meetings to read them a sampling of each type of tale, which will help to reinforce the similarities and differences.

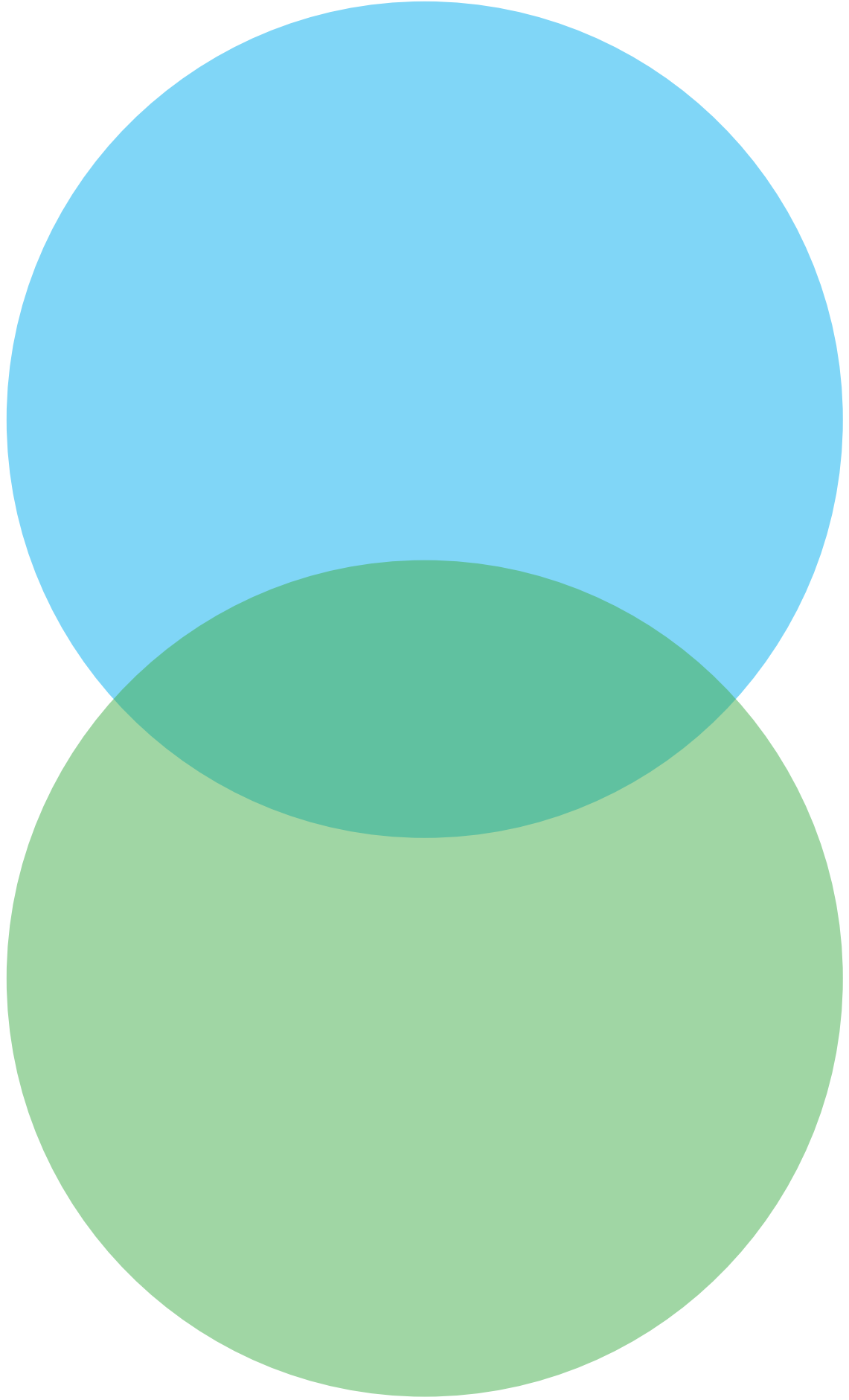

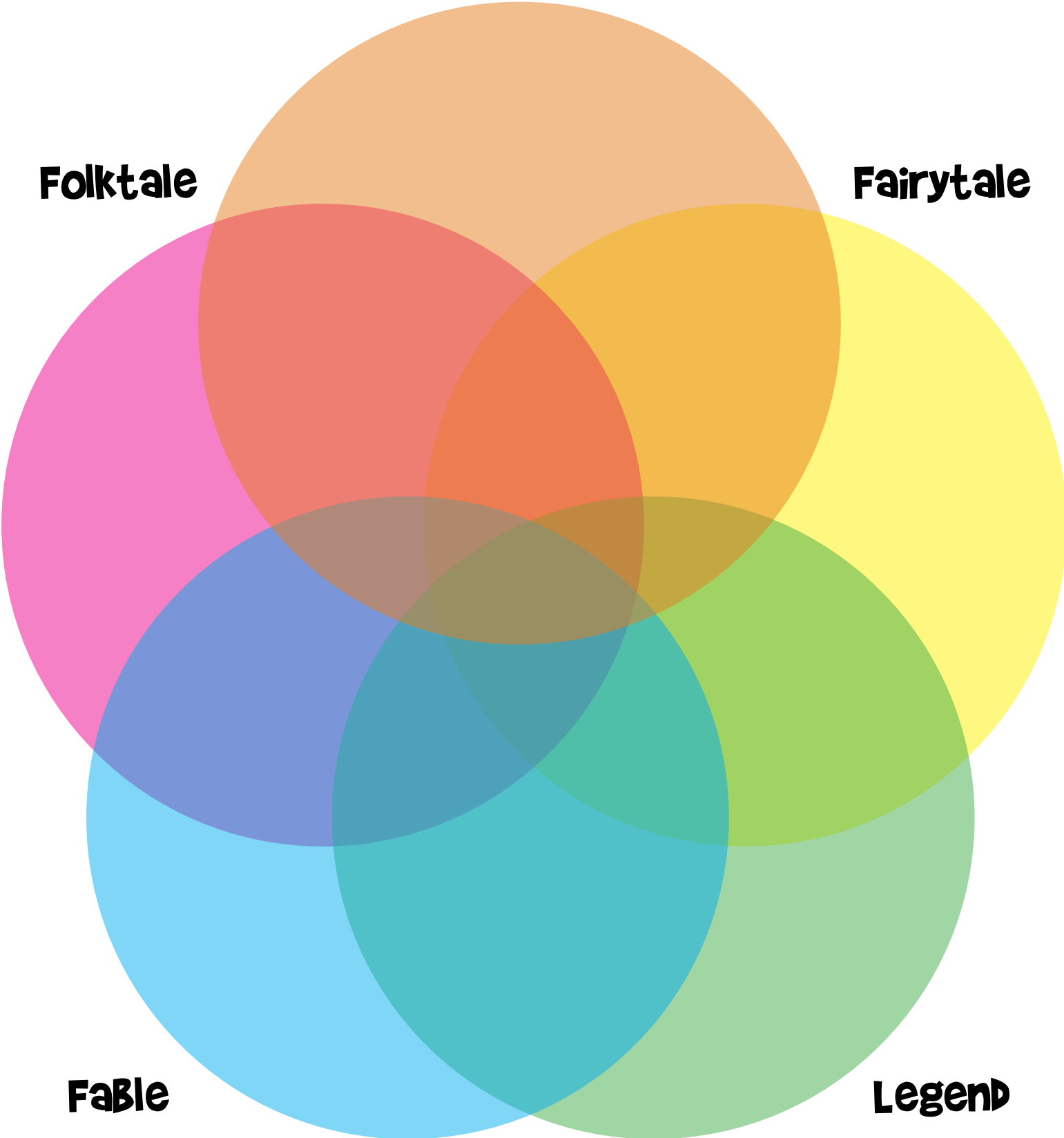
